3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF FINAL OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 BRA will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations – Detailed information is available on the ISSF website https://www.issf-

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for

random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

4. Participation

Individual Events

Each ISSF Member Federation can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per event. There will be no Qualification Ranking for the Olympic Games (QROG) nor ISSF Ranking Points (RPO). Athletes who have already obtained a Quota Place for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games are allowed to participate in this Championship.

Mixed Team Events

Mixed team events will be included in the Competition Schedule. These events are: 10m Air Pistol Mixed Team, 10m Air Rifle Mixed Team. ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each ISSF FINAL OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 BRA event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until 15 days before the Official Arrival day, which is **27 MAR 2024.**

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries is possible without restriction and additional fees.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 8 APR 2024 onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **8 APR 2024** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (11 MAR 2024) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Gun License

IMPORTANT

According to Brazilian law, it's mandatory that all members of the Delegation fill in the **e-DBV** (Traveller's Electronic Declaration of Goods) on-line document for Customs prior to your arrival in Brazil at the following site:

https://www.edbv.receita.fazenda.gov.br/edbv-viajante/pages/selecionarAcao/selecionarAcao.jsf.

Please, send us an exported e-DBV PDF to finalbra2024.firearms@gmail.com immediately after filling in the e-DBV on the site. If the athlete needs to change any firearm after this process, remember that is necessary to update the document on the site and send us the new one.

The Organizing Committee strongly recommends bringing 2 copies of the e-DBV printed and correctly filled to the ease of the arrival.

The Organizing Committee recommends the federations to arrive in Brazil as early as possible before 11 Apr 2024 in order to avoid a great number of athletes at the same date on the Customs. The ranges will be opened for training from 1 Apr 2024.

Custom Clearance - Arrival

At the airport of arrival in Brazil, after finishing the immigration process, athletes must follow to the customs' **red line** in the arrival's hall, **present firearms and ammunition to the Brazilian Army officers** for inspection and withdrawal of the transit permits, and then go to the tax authority officials for customs clearance, where e-DBV form will be requested for checking.

Firearms must always be accompanied by their transit permits wherever they go.

Once these procedures have been completed, athletes must go to the exit gate of the international arrival's hall. Outside the delegations will meet the Organizing Committee staff to board in the vehicles of the transport service of the competition.

All participating federations must declare all of firearms and ammunitions brought to Brazil for the ISSF FINAL OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION CHAMPIONSHIP in advance. They are kindly requested to complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) and must return it together with passport copies of each athlete as early as possible, but not later than **26 FEB 2024.** Forms must be typed in **PC ONLY**, not handwritten or transmitted by fax. A fee of EUR 50.00 will be charged to each athlete and official for the clearance of weapons and/or ammunition that will be checked in Brazil, including air guns.

It is not necessary to declare pellets. Only declare ammunition for firearm.

Delegations that need to prove to the airline companies and airport authorities that their athletes are carrying their weapons and ammunition to participate in competition in Brazil may request a declara-

tion from the Organizing Committee, who will attest that the gun permits will be given to the athletes upon arrival at the Country.

All delegations are requested to arrange the **GIG Airport (Rio de Janeiro Tom Jobim International Airport – Galeão)** for arrival and departure. Main international airlines can reach GIG Airport directly. If there is any delegation or athlete who choose a flight that the first stop in Brazil will be at GRU Airport (Sao Paulo), the custom process will be not automatic and can take much more time than in GIG. In this case, it's strongly recommended to have a **connecting flight with minimum 7 hours from GRU to GIG**, because Brazilian government requests that the custom formalities for all luggage and firearms must be made at the first international airport of Brazil Territory upon arrival. There will be an additional charge of EUR 50.00 for each clearance made at GRU airport, regarding costs with the local dispatcher who will assist in the clearance process.

Additionally, for those who choose to arrive in Brazil by GRU Airport, it will be mandatory to send the following information to the Organizing Committee, up to 10 days before the arrival date, for each athlete or official:

- E-mail;
- Phone number with area and country code;
- Address:
- Airline ticket copy.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for losses of flight connections and baggage at GRU before arriving in GIG. Countries with connecting flight in GRU must fly to GIG in a domestic flight. It will also bring consequences about limit of quantity and luggage weight.

Arrivals to Brazil by other airports than GIG or GRU will not be accepted. Arrivals to Brazil by Bus or Car will not be accepted also.

Entry Visas

The participating federations, which require entry visa into Brazil, are kindly requested to obtain it before departure from their country. If needed, please fill in the enclosed Visa Support Form (Annex 7) and send it to the Organizing Committee (finalbra2024.contact@gmail.com) in time but not later than 11 FEB 2024. Upon request, the Organizing Committee will send Official Invitation Letter to apply for their entry visa at the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries, or where required in case of countries having no diplomatic relations with Brazil.

The Brazilian Shooting Sport Confederation has no influence on the embassy and can provide the invitation regarding the ISSF World Cup only!

Custom Clearance – Departure

The clearance of firearms and ammunitions will take place in 2 steps:

1st step – at the competition venue: each athlete, after ending his last event, must withdraw his weapons and equipments from the armory and present them with the documentation received upon arrival at the airport to the Brazilian Army office. After the check procedures, the athlete must take the firearms and equipments with their documentation to the hotel or to the airport, if that is the day of his departure.

A room will be available at the competition venue with computer and printer for athletes to fill out and print the Federal Police form, which must be presented at the airport, along with the weapon's documentation.

2nd step – at the airport: upon arrival to check in, the athlete must present his firearms and ammunitions and their documentation to the customs authorities (Revenue and Federal Police officials) for final clearance.

Athletes Under 18 Years Old

According to Brazilian Federal Law 8.069/90 (Child and Teenager Statute), athletes up to the age of 18 must have the appropriate authorization form completed and provide proper documentation to be eligible to compete.

This authorization is obtained through a Mandatory Court Permit, which requires a special procedure. The procedure for minors participating in competitions requires the following documents:

- Authorization form signed by the parent or legal guardian of the athlete, expressly containing
 the name of the person who is authorized to accompany and who will be entirely responsible
 for the minor during the competition;
- Copy of the ID or passport of the athlete that contains his/her photo and the name of his/her parents or legal guardian;
- Copy of the ID or passport of the athlete's parents or legal guardian that signed the authorization form;
- Copy of the passport or ID of the person indicated in the authorization form to be responsible for the athlete during the competition days;
- Medical certificate;
- Schooling statement.

The lack of documentation or proper procedure to obtain authorization of the minor may obligate the athlete to abandon the competition, due to on-site inspection from Minor's Court authority or even cause the cancelation of the competition, so the Organizing Committee will not allow the participation of a minor athlete who does not meet these requirements.

We kindly request that the federation previously inform the Organizing Committee of the participation of a minor athlete, to obtain guidance on legal procedures.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel - Arrival

All arrival and departure must be from GIG International Airport - Galeão, Rio de Janeiro.

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the airport to the shooting range to leave the guns and then to the official hotels. Transportation back to the airport will be provided as well. The official transportation begins on 10 APR 2024 (at 08:00 PM) and ends on 20 APR 2024 (at 8:00 PM)

Airport pick up - Transportation to the Official Hotels (and back for departure)

The GIG airport is located 20 km from the CMTE Shooting Range.

The CMTE Shooting Range is located 25 km from the official hotels.

Upon arrival all delegations must take the transportation to the shooting range, leave the guns and go to the official hotels.

Transfer service to and from GIG airport on arrival and departure has a EUR 60.00 fee per athlete / official (round trip).

Local Transportation - Shuttle Service

Technical Meeting

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

Gun storage will be provided conveniently at the shooting range (next to the main entrance). Firearms and ammunition will not be transported to and from the hotels, except on departure. A storage space will be provided for equipment bags and ammunition at the shooting range.

Ammunition

The following ammunition will be available at the Shooting Range:

.22 Eley Tenex Pistol – 26.00 EURO for a box of 50 cartridges; .22 Eley Match – 22.00 EURO for a box of 50 cartridges.

Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 12 Apr 2024, at 09:00h, at the Rifle/Pistol Finals Hall. We kindly request each federation to select a Flag bearer in order to represent the NF in the opening ceremony.

There will be no Closing Ceremony.

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the Rifle/Pistol Finals Hall immediately after the end of each Finals, except to the 3 Positions event (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

The organizing committee will have a photo position in the shooting range, close to the armory to take a picture of each athlete upon arrival. The picture will be used in the athlete's individual presentation during the finals. We encourage the athletes to use their national uniform.
