# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Detailed information about the current ISSF Rules and Regulations is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

The ESC Challenge events will be conducted according to the ESC General Regulations and ESC Challenge rules – Detailed information is available on the ESC website <a href="https://esc-shooting.org/documents/escrules">https://esc-shooting.org/documents/escrules</a>

The Juries (Competition Jury, RTS/ Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ESC to supervise the Championship. Qualified Range Officers holding applicable ISSF Licenses will conduct the competitions.

#### **EQUIPMENT CONTROL :**

ISSF rules for equipment control could evolute. We will use the updated rules during this European Championship. You fill find below some information about the actual rules. **An online booking will be organized. More information to come.** 

#### **RIFLE/PISTOL EQUIPMENT**

All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not according to ISSF Rules.

#### **RIFLE CLOTHING**

Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time. No new seal will be added during the European championship.

#### **RIFLE CLOTHING POST-COMPETITION STIFFNESS TESTING**

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

#### SHOTGUN EQUIPMENT

Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition. Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre- competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.



#### Individual Events - See ESC General Regulations - 12.0

#### ISSF/ESC Events Individual

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in the individual events. A maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation entered in 50m Rifle 3 Positions, 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men, 25m Pistol Women, Trap and Skeet individual events can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. Two (2) other athletes entered in individual events can compete for ranking points only (RPO). The RPO athletes cannot neither proceed to the Final nor establish records - ESC General Regulation 12.3.

If there are more than 3 athletes in non-Olympic events, these have to be declared as RPO during the Online Registration process – but of course at the ECH all 4 or 5 will have the same "status".

#### Team (as per ISSF rules)

Only 3 athletes from the same age category and gender can be registered as a team, and they must be officially declared at the accreditation office as per ISSF rules. Only 1 team per MF is allowed. All athletes must be in competition. RPO Athletes cannot be part of the team.

#### Mixed Team events

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams.

# ESC Challenge Events

Solo

The athletes participating in a Trap/Skeet Solo Competition are determined according to the Final Ranking of the respective Trap/Skeet individual ISSF/ESC recognized event held during the European Championship prior to the Solo event. ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation.

#### Trio

ESC Member Federations may enter only 1 Trio. The registration of the athletes in the Trio Events (each trio will be composed of three (3) members). The Trio must be composed of the participants of the respective Solo events. Each of the three (3) athletes entered in the competition must be registered by the set deadline but may be changed for other athletes registered in the Championship by latest 12:00 the day before the start of the Competition

#### Duet

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) pairs consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per duet event. But only two (2) pairs will procced to the 2nd part of Qualification. Juniors may compete as part of the Men/Women team in case they are not part of the Men/Women Junior team at the same Championship as per article ESC General Regulations 12.12.

A maximum of two (2) Duet Pair of one nation entered in Duet Pair events (Duet Pair 1 and Duet Pair 2) can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other Duet Pair (Duet Pair 3) cannot qualify to the Final - ESC General Regulation 12.4



#### Juniors

Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Any athlete born between the 1st January and the 31st December, will cease to be a Junior on the 31<sup>st</sup> December of that year.- ESC General Regulation 11.2

In the European Championships Juniors each Member Federation can enter a maximum of six (6) athletes in the Individual events, two (2) mixed teams, three (3) Duet Pair in the respective Duet Pair events and one (1) Team in the respective Team events and 1 Trio in Trio events. At least two (2) of those athletes entered in the Individual events must be from U-18 age category. A maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation, the three top-ranked after Qualification, may proceed to the Final as per ISSF rule 3.7.5.3.

Juniors may compete as part of the Men/Women duet/trio in case they are not part of the Men/Women Junior duet/trio at the same Championship as per article ESC General Regulations 12.12.

#### **Maximum Entry**

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each European Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

# **ISSF ID Number**

All athletes must sign the **new "Athlete's Declaration"** and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the European Championships.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

4. ENTRY PROCESS

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF

Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email **will not be accepted**.

#### **Preliminary Entries**

ESC Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration

System at https://shootingsportscloud.com.

The Preliminary Entry Deadline is 20 APRIL 2025.

#### **Final Entries**

ESC Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System

at https://shootingsportscloud.com.

The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is 23 JUNE 2025.

#### **Late Entries**

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **19 JULY 2025.** 

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

a) Change of names / athletes within an event

b) Change of Status (ECH athlete 🚭 "RPO only" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **20 JULY 2025** onwards, may not participate.

#### **Entry Confirmation upon arrival**

All Team Leaders of ESC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

#### Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **20 JULY 2025** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.
- b) Change of Status in an event: an "RPO only" athlete can replace a withdrawn "ECH" athlete.

# Cancellation

Any ESC Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**23 JUNE 2025**) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the registration online. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

# Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ESC/ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the ECH Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

# 6. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

#### **Entry Visa**

France is a member of the European Union.

EU Nationals are able to enter France with a valid passport or with a valid ID Card. Those Federations who need a specific Invitation Letter to apply for a Sport Visa, must contact the Organizing Committee, **not later than 1st June 2025** on e-mail: <u>ech2025@gmail.com</u>

#### **Customs Formalities, Import of Firearms**

#### 3 possibilities :

#### A – For EU Member State

When entering France, you will need to have an invitation letter and claim possession of the firearms to the police officer when crossing the border. This invitation will be sent to each nation as soon as the LOC will receive the Annex 2.11 Firearm Form for Invitation.

Persons with an EU firearm permits just have to show the EU firearms permit to the police officer and do not need to show any other forms or pay any taxes **unless they don't enter France with more than 6 firearms. II won't be possible to travel back with any ammunition.** 

#### **B - For Countries outside the EU**

Delegations will have to present to French customs :

- The invitation which will be sent after receiving Annex 2.11 Firearm Form for Invitation
- Annex 2.12 filled One form per athlete This form will have to be presented to French customs at airport arrival in order to be stamped. Important : this official document will also have to be presented at French Customs at the airport on the way back (same office). It won't be possible to travel back with any ammunition.

#### **C** - Countries subject to restriction

Russia and Belarus are subject to restrictions for firearm import and will have to fill special documents to access France (with LOC help) with their firearms and ammunition. They will receive special documents and information directly from LOC.

#### 7. OFFICIAL HOTEL/ACCOMMODATION

The annex 7 gives all details for all hotels that can be booked. Most of them are within 15 minutes by bus from the shooting range. Not all of them have a restaurant then please be check this information of the hotel's website.

In order to have a big number of rooms very near the range , the LOC has chosen to book the "PESI" which was the place of the Olympic Athlete Village during Paris 2024. This center is situated at only 2 minutes from the range but is not an hotel. It was completely renovated for the OG but the rooms are not equipped with TV and air – conditioned. The breakfast (included in the price of the room) and the diner (to be booked later) will be proposed in this center.

First payment for hotel booking(80 %) will have to be made on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2025.

#### **TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION** 8.

The Organizing Committee will provide the transport service for all the delegations between the official airports and the official hotels during the official days of the 2025 European Championship - 22 JULY -> 7 AUGUST 2025

The official airports are:

- 1. Airport Paris CDG
- 2. Airport Paris Orly

The transportation from Paris Airports will be charged **140 € per person (**both ways). The pick-up service at these airports is only for those who are in official hotels. On the first arrival days, the shuttle hours will be at :

- 11:00 AM
- 2:00 PM
- 5:00 PM

After these first days, LOC will adapt the schedule with the arrivals of the delegation and the details of this transport schedule will be sent before arrival.

For any arrival after this shuttle hours, the nations will have to book their own hotel at the airport and take the shuttle on the next day because the time to go to Châteauroux is around 4 hours and bus drivers are not always allowed to drive during the night in July.

#### Attention : transportation time on the 25, 26 and 27th of July could be much longer because of holidays departure on the road which cause a lot of traffic jam.

Transportation fee for Paris – Châteauroux – Paris will be charged 140 €/ person

The Organizing Committee will also provide local transportation daily between the official hotels and the shooting range, according to the official transport schedule. The transport service will be effective from July 22 till August 7, 2025.

No assistance or transportation will be provided to the participants lodged in unofficial

hotels.

The Delegations deciding to arrive before 22 JULY 2025 or leave after 7 AUGUST will have to make their own transfer arrangements, otherwise, on request, the Organizing Committee will organize assistance and/or transportation at the Delegation's expense.

All transportation services requested in the "Final Travel Form", not cancelled within three (3) days before arrival, will be applicable by the Organizing Committee according to the number of passengers appearing in the "Final Travel Form" for which the service has been required.



# 9. COMPETITION RELATED PROCEDURES

#### Technical Meeting See schedule Place : Final hall

Each participating ESC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Championships.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

#### Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

Storage of guns and ammunition is available at the armory on the shooting range. It will be opened each day from 07:00 or 6:30 to 1 hour after the end of last event/training this day.

#### Ammunition

There will be no ammunition sales for pistol and rifle.

2 brands of shotgun cartridges will be proposed on sale. The details of these brands will be communicated by the beginning of June.

#### **Doping Control Tests**

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and under the supervision of the I.T.A.

**10.** CEREMONIES

#### **Opening and Closing Ceremony**

Opening Ceremony will be on the 24 July 2025. Closing after the last medal ceremony on 6 August 2025
