## Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All pistols must be registered in ISSF database. Pistols that have not been registered or recorded must be checked for compliance with ISSF Rules and registered to the athlete.

## Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF Seals with serial numbers on their jackets, trousers and shoes. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF Seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. All existing ISSF seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates issued to jackets and trousers will cease to be valid as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026. All those items of clothing must be submitted to Equipment Control for testing at the first opportunity when attending an ISSF Championship so that new seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates will be issued. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

## Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified and further procedures will take place. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

## Air or CO<sub>2</sub> Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO<sub>2</sub> cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control. Please be aware that in some countries it is a federal offence to use outdated compressed gas cylinders.

## Shotgun Equipment

All Skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on their Skeet marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the Skeet marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for Shotguns or Skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

## Buttstock Height (for Skeet only)

The height of the buttstock (either adjustable or "Monte Carlo" type) measured from the highest point of the cheek rest to the lowest point of the butt plate toe must not exceed 170mm (17cm). Any butt plate

toe vertical extension which is not an integral part of the buttstock and simply intended to increase its height, is not permitted.

## **Cartridge Control**

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all eight (8) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once cartridges are placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove cartridges from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Final (There will be no elimination for 8<sup>th</sup> place; the first elimination will be for 7<sup>th</sup> place).

## **Colored Wads**

Any ejecta (Wad), except for the shot or powder, must be transparent or translucent. The shot must not have any color added. No other element can be added that could be distinguished as a Hit Target.

## **Equipment Control**

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

## **4. Participation**

### **Individual Events**

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of six (6) athletes per individual event. A maximum of three (3) athletes per country (the three top ranked after Qualification) may proceed to the Final.

### **Mixed Team Events**

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

### **Maximum Entry / Range Capacity**

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

## ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF Junior World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

## Juniors

Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Therefore, for the ISSF Junior World Cup Cairo 2026 athletes must be born in 2005 or later.

## 5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 6) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

### Preliminary Entries

## Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **15 APR 2026**.

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries are possible without restrictions and additional fees.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **16 APR 2026** onwards, may not participate.

## Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

## Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **16 APR** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

## Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**20 MAR 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

## Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training for Shotgun.

They DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial Training for Shotgun.

## Payment of Entry Fees

## Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF Junior World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

**There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.**

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

## 6. Shooting Range

The ISSF Junior World Cup will take place at the Egypt International Olympic City in Cairo, Egypt.

### Rifle/Pistol

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range	Description
10m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
25m range	60 firing points (12 groups); electronic targets, SIUS AG
50m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
Finals hall	15 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 25m and 50m range is north.

### Shotgun

The shooting range has ten (10) combined ranges for Trap/Skeet.

The shooting range is equipped with Mattarelli machines and Elettronica Progetti acoustic release system.

All ranges are equipped with Elettronica Progetti electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for the ISSF Junior World Cup are eco-friendly from Laporte, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The Egyptian Shooting Federation has **no influence** on the embassies.

The Egyptian Shooting Federation can provide invitations for the period of the ISSF Junior World Cup Cairo 2026 only.

## Custom Formalities, Temporary Import of Firearms

ISSF Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Egypt for the ISSF Junior World Cup in advance. **All federations must complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) clearly and return it with scanned copies of valid passports for each athlete to the Organizing Committee by email not later than 1 MAR 2026.** Please make sure that the firearm document should be sent to the Organizing Committee not later than thirty (30) days before the arrival in case of the arrival earlier than the official arrival day (19 APR 2026).

**Please type in PC ONLY (no handwriting) on the Word Form (do not use a PDF format) when completing the Firearms Form and send it back by email (No Fax transmission will be accepted)!**

The charge for a firearms permit is **EUR 25.00 per firearm**. This must be wired to the Organizing Committee account in advance or paid to the Organizing Committee at the shooting range.

The Official Airport for customs clearance of firearms is **Cairo Airport**.

The Organizing Committee staff will assist firearms clearance in the customs channel. All athletes must go directly to the customs after baggage claim at arrival to verify that the serial numbers of their own firearms are identical with the ones declared in advance.

**Please note that any firearm that was not declared in advance on the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) or was not correctly declared, cannot be released and will be kept in the custody of customs on arrival. If it is necessary to make or correct a firearm declaration upon arrival, authorization to release the firearm will take at least 3 days.**

## 9. Travel and Transportation

### Travel – Arrival

The official airport for pickup service at arrival and departure is **Cairo Airport**.

### Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

All delegations registered within the deadline will be welcomed by the Organizing Committee staff at the exit of your arrival gate. Airport pick-up service will be available during the official days of the ISSF Junior World Cup, from **19 APR to 27 APR 2026 only**.

The armory will be open from 06:30 to 19:30. Every day the armory staff and police will check to confirm that all firearms and ammunitions were returned to the armory after training / competition.

The federations that wish to arrive earlier than **19 APR 2026** or leave later than **27 APR 2026** must pay an additional fee to use the armory, which is **EUR 100.00 per federation**. This fee must be paid to the Organizing Committee with entry fees.

## Ammunition

There is no limitation on the quantity of ammunition that participants can bring into Egypt for the purpose of training and competition during the ISSF Junior World Cup, if the amount of ammunition is declared to the Organizing Committee by the deadline **1 MAR 2026**.

Please be advised **that it is prohibited to sell any Rifle and Pistol ammunition (including air pellets) in Egypt between delegations only through the Organizing Committee**. Delegations are requested to bring all necessary Rifle and Pistol ammunition to be used in training and competition.

All participating federations are required to bring with them at least one (1) of their national flags (minimum size: 1.20m x 80cm approximately) and one (1) national anthem mp4-format on a flash memory stick (40– 50 seconds).
