3. Rules and Regulations


The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All pistols must be registered in ISSF database. Pistols that have not been registered or recorded must be checked for compliance with ISSF Rules and registered to the athlete.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF Seals with serial numbers on their jackets, trousers and shoes. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF Seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. All existing ISSF seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates issued to jackets and trousers will cease to be valid as from 1st January 2026. All those items of clothing must be submitted to Equipment Control for testing at the first opportunity when attending an ISSF Championship so that new seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates will be issued. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified and further procedures will take place. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control. Please be aware that in some countries it is a federal offence to use outdated compressed gas cylinders.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO). RPO starts are only possible if there are more than three (3) starts in an event.


Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

The **Final Entry Deadline** (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **6 MAR 2026**.


Late Entries

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of status ("Medal" athlete ↔ "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **2 APR 2026** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **2 APR 2026** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) Status exchange of a registered athlete for competing in the Final for Medals and of a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**6 MAR 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.



Please transfer all payments not later than **5 MAR 2026**.

All amounts must be paid in EUR and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data will be transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the right ISSF Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

All payments made at the shooting range must be paid in cash in EUR to the Organizing Committee upon arrival (no credit cards or traveler's checks will be accepted).

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.



7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visa

All nations that will need an official invitation of the Royal Spanish Shooting Federation are requested to order these before **5 MAR 2026** (Annex 5). Please provide the Visa Support Form typed on PC and as a word document.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The Royal Spanish Shooting Federation has no influence on the embassies and can provide invitations for the period of the ISSF World Cup Granada 2026 only!

Custom Formalities, Import of Firearms, Firearm License

ISSF Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Spain for the ISSF World Cup in advance. All federations must complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) clearly and return it with scanned copies of valid passports for each athlete to the Organizing Committee by email. Please make sure that the firearm document will be sent to the Organizing Committee not later than thirty (30) days before the arrival (**5 MAR 2026**) in case of the arrival earlier than the official arrival day.

Please type in PC ONLY (no handwriting) on the Word Form (do not use a PDF format) when completing the Firearm and Ammunition Form and send it back by email.

After that the ISSF Member Federations will receive a **Firearm Permit**. This exceptional authorization will be valid for the days they declare in the Firearm and Ammunition Form.

Please make sure that your Team Leaders as well as athletes who arrive or depart alone carry with them the General Permission as well as the list of all registered firearms and ammunition to be presented to the customs.

The charge for the **firearms permit is EUR 30.00 per athlete**. This must be wired to the Organizing Committee account in advance or paid to the Organizing Committee at the shooting range upon arrival.





9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

The official airport is the Granada National Airport, located 17km by motorway from the official hotels. This airport offers excellent travel connections with Madrid.

130km away is the Malaga-Costa del Sol Airport, with more connecting flights to Europe.

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

Due the number of delegations arriving the day before the Official Arrival Day, official pick-up service starts already on **4 APR 2026**. Delegations that leave after the Official Departure Day (**13 APR 2026**) must make their own arrangements.

The person in charge will meet you directly at the exit after baggage claim and customs. They will carry a sign with the ISSF World Cup logo.

Transportation from/to the Granada airport or Granada main train station to the official hotels will be offered during the official competition days and includes a stop at the shooting range in order to store firearms there.

The Organizing Committee will provide the transport service from Malaga airport and will be charged with **80 EUR per person** (both ways).

All delegations must inform the Organizing Committee about their arrival and departure details in time

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

Local transportation between the official hotels and the shooting range will also be arranged by the Organizing Committee **during training and competition days only (5 APR – 12 APR 2026)**.

The Technical Meeting will take place on **6 APR 2026**, at the shooting range.



Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

During your stay in Spain (Granada) all firearms and ammunition must be stored in the armory on the shooting range only. The armory is open from 5 APR – 13 APR 2026.

It is not allowed to take any firearms and ammunition out of the shooting range and especially not to the hotels. This Spanish law also must be followed strictly by nations that are in the possession of a European Firearms Passport (EFP)! The complete armory inventory will be checked every evening to be sure all firearms are returned!

Arrival:

Upon your arrival in Spain, all firearms and ammunition must be transported to the shooting range **in the most direct way**. All delegations entering Spain with the Gun Permit must store their firearms and ammunition on the shooting range **ONLY**.

Departure:

All firearms and ammunition must be transported from the armory at the shooting range to the airport **in the most direct way**.

Ammunition

Ammunition can be purchased at the shooting range. Please order the needed ammunition in advance (not later than **5 MAR 2026**) stating the quantity and brand. Please send an e-mail with your detailed order to the Organizing Committee.

Doping Control Tests

Doping Controls Tests will be conducted in accordance with the actual ISSF Anti-Doping Rules.

11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

There will be no Opening and no Closing Ceremonies.

Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range or the Finals Hall immediately after the end of each Finals or at the end of the competition day (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need flags and anthems from the participating ISSF Member Federations.


12. Weather Information
